

New Ulm Police Department – LELS #150 Scholarship

Background

This scholarship is not associated with the City of New Ulm or directly with the New Ulm Police Department. It is funded by the union dues of the police officers of the City of New Ulm. The New Ulm Police Officers that make up Law Enforcement Labor Services #150 (LELS #150) are dedicated to helping those wanting to become peace officers reach their goal and have established this scholarship.

The Award

This award involves a \$250.00, one-time scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded after the successful completion of the first semester of college of a law enforcement based education. The financial award will be provided to the student's high school where they will have to show the business office the successful completion of the first semester of classes.

Who is Eligible?

Any graduating senior from New Ulm Public High School, New Ulm Area Catholic Schools, or is a full-time resident with their parents/guardian who resides in the City of New Ulm and attends Minnesota Valley Lutheran High School.

Application Process

- Complete the application **following all instructions.**
- Complete a handwritten essay of at least 350 words on “Why I want to pursue a career in law enforcement”
- Provide a copy of acceptance letter to a 2 or 4 year college for law enforcement/criminal justice.

DEADLINE

The completed application and supporting materials must be received in the high school guidance office no later than March 31st 2022.
